Easy care Perfection Worsted Weight yarn is used for this beautiful sweater where the cables wind and intertwine.

Rambling Brambles

Pattern written in smaller size with larger sizes in parentheses. If only one number is given it applies to all sizes.

Back:

With smaller needles CO 120 (128,136,144) sts.

K2 TBL, P2 ribbing for 2 ½".
K one row.

Change to larger needles and PM between patts.

Work **Patt A** for 18 (22, 26, 30) sts, **Patt B** for 2 sts, **Patt C** for 17 sts, **Patt D1** for 9 sts, **Patt E** for 28 sts, **Patt D2** for 9 sts, **Patt C** 17 sts, **Patt B** for 2 sts, and **Patt A** for 18 (22, 26, 30) sts.

Work in patt as est until 22" (23", 24", 25)" or desired length to shoulder.

BO 20 sts at the beg of the next 4 rows to shape shoulder.

Place rem 40 (48, 56, 64) sts on a st holder for back neck.

Front:

Work same as back until 14 (16, 18, 20) rows less than back at start of shoulder shaping, end with a WS row.

Work in patt as est next 48 (52, 56, 60) sts only for first shoulder, turn.

Cont to work in patt and shape neck. BO 3 (4, 5, 6) sts at neck edge once, BO 2 (3, 4, 5) sts once, then dec 1 st every row 3 (5, 7, 9) times.

When same length as back at arm edge, BO 20 sts at arm edge every other row 2 times to shape shoulder.

Place center 24 sts on a st holder for front neck.

Join yarn to rem 48 (52, 56, 60) sts and work other shoulder, rep shaping at neck edge and then shoulder shaping at arm edge.

Sleeves:

With smaller needles CO 40 (44, 48, 52) sts.

Work in K2 TBL, P2 ribbing for 3 ½".
K one row.

Inc row: K2, [K1, KFB] 5 times, [KFB] 15 (19, 23, 27) times, [K1, KFB] 5 times, K3.

Total of 65 (73, 81, 89) sts after inc.

Change to larger needles and PM between patts.

Work **Patt A** for 22 (26, 30, 34) sts, **Patt B** for 2 sts, **Patt C** for 17 sts, **Patt B** for 2 sts, and **Patt A** for 22 (26, 30, 34) sts.

Work in patt as est, inc 1 st each side every 4th row until 121 (129,137,145) sts.

Cont in patt until 18" (18 ½", 19", 19 ½") or desired length for sleeve. End with a WS row and BO.

Neckband:

Sew shoulder seams front to back. With smaller needle K sts from back neck st holder. Pick up 12 (14, 16, 17) sts along left side of neck. K the sts from front neck st holder, and pick up 12 (14, 16, 17) sts along right side of neck, PM.

Rnd 1: K1, P1

Rnd 2: K1 TBL, P1

Rep Rnd 1 & 2 for 1". BO loosely in patt.

Finishing:

Placing center of sleeve at shoulder seam, sew sleeves to body of sweater. Sew underarm seam of sleeves and front to back at side seams. Weave in ends and block if needed.

Note: Grey symbols indicate that the cables are crossed to the right.




