# Wavy Baby Sweater

The knit and purl wave stitch on the body of the sweater and panel on the sleeves will hold your interest while you make this baby cardigan. Stockinette stitch makes the raglan sleeve shaping easy.



**Wave Stitch pattern:** (8 st rep + 3) *Refer to chart, the 8 st repeat is framed.*

K1 edge st on right edge and k2 edge sts on left edge. Body is worked in one piece without side seams.

**Begin at Bottom:** With smaller needles CO 107 (115, 123) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, \*P1, K2: rep from \* to end.

Row 2 (WS): P2, \*K1, P2: rep from \* to end.

Rows 3 - 8: Rep rows 1 & 2.

**Purl Ridge:** Change to larger needles.

Row 9: P

Row 10: K

Row 11: P

Row 12: P

**Wave St chart:**

K 1 st as edge st, beginning with Row 1 of chart work 8 st rep of chart 13 (14, 15) times across row, K 2 rem sts as edge sts. Maintain edge sts and cont to work rows 1 - 6 of chart 6 (7, 8) times approx. 6" (6 ¾", 7½").

**For the next 4 rows: Repeat Purl Ridge**

**Armholes:** Divide front and back as follows for armholes. Use extra size #6 needle for back sts.

**Set-up Row (RS):**

K 22 (24, 26) sts for Right Front.

Attach a second ball of yarn and with a new needle BO 6 sts and K 51 (55, 59) sts for Back.

Attach a third ball of yarn and on same needle as Right Front BO 6 sts and K 22 (24, 26) sts for Left Front.

The Back is on one needle and Right and Left Front on a second needle. Let the fronts rest and work back for raglan shaping. The remainder of the back and fronts are worked in St st. Dec are made on RS rows, P the WS rows.

**Dec Row for Back Armhole edges (RS):** K1, SSK, K until 3 sts rem. K2tog, K1.

**Wave Stitch Chart** (for body of sweater)

## Wavy Baby Sweater

**Back Raglan:** P all WS rows.

Dec row for back armhole edges every 4 rows 2 (0, 0) times, then next

Dec row for back armhole edges every 2 rows 12 (16, 18) times.

Armhole depth will be 32 (32, 36 rows). Place 23 sts on stitch holder for back neck.

Begin working the Right Front and Left Front. You can work both side by side but separately, or first the Right Front and then the Left Front. Use the Right Front Dec Rows for the Right Armhole edge and the Right Neck edge shaping, which happen at the same time.

***\*Note: Shaping for the Armhole edge and the Neck edge happen at the same time.\****

**Right Front:** P all WS rows.

**Dec Row for Right Front Armhole edge (RS):**

K until 3 sts rem, K2tog, K1.

**Dec Row for Right Front Neck edge (RS):**

K1, SSK, K to end of row.

Begin working Right Front shaping armhole and neck edge at the same time.

Right Front Armhole edge Dec Row every 4 rows 2 (0, 0) time.

Next, Right Front Armhole edge Dec Row every 2 rows 12 (16, 18) times.

**And at the same time work Right Front Neck edge Dec Row.**

Right Front Neck edge Dec Row every 4 rows 8 times.

Armhole depth will be 32 (32, 36 rows) to match rows of back. Fasten off last st.

**Left Front:** P all WS rows.

**Dec Row for Left Front Armhole edge (RS):** K1, SSK, K to end of row.

**Dec Row for Left Front Neck edge (RS):** K until 3 sts rem, K2tog, K1.

Reverse shaping for left front using the left front armhole edge Dec Row and left front neck edge Dec Row. Armhole depth will be 32 (32, 36 rows) to match rows of back. Fasten off last st.

**Sleeves (make 2):** You can work sleeves side by side but separately by using 2 balls of yarn. With smaller needles CO 41 (43, 45) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P1, K2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS):** P2, \* K1, P2; rep from \* to end

**Rows 3 - 8:** Rep Rows 1 & 2.

Change to larger needles.

<p><b>Pattern:</b>          R1 (RS): p3, k3, p1, k3, p3          R2 (WS): k3, p2, k3, p2, k3          R3: p3, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p3          R4: k5, p3, k5          R5: p4, k5, p4          R6: k3, p7, k3          R7: p3, k3, p1, k3, p3          R8: k3, p2, k3, p2, k3          R9: p3, k1, p2, k1, p2, k1, p3          R10: k5, p3, k5          R11: p4, k5, p4          R12: k3, p7, k3</p>
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**Set up Row (RS):** K14 (15, 16) sts. PM, work 13 sts of Row 1 of Sleeve Chart (rep framed in chart), PM, K14 (15, 16) sts.

**Next row:** P to marker, work row 2 of chart, P after marker.

Cont to work in St st to marker, rep rows 1 - 6 of Sleeve Chart between markers. St st after marker. Inc on Row 6 of chart

**Sleeve Inc Row:** K1, KFB, work as est until 2 sts rem, KFB, K1. Work Inc Row on Row 6 of chart 3 (4, 5) times (47, 51, 53 sts).

Cont in chart as established without inc until 6 (7, 8) reps are worked approx. 6½" (7¼", 8")

**Armhole:** BO 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

**Dec Row for Armhole edge (RS):** K1, SSK, work until 3 sts rem, K2tog, K1.

**Raglan Sleeve Cap Shaping:** Maintain sleeve chart as est. P all WS rows.

Dec row for Armhole edge every 2 rows 10 (14, 14) times.

Dec row for armhole edge every 4 rows 3 (1, 2) times.

When you have 32 (32, 36) rows, place remaining 13 sts on a holder.

**Finishing:** With raglan shaping it's important to make the seams as neatly as possible. If needed, with wrong sides facing loosely baste pieces tog ½ st from the edge, then working from the right side use the Mattress st to sew between the first and second st from the edge to finish seam. The basting thread can be removed.

Sew the underarm seams of the sleeves. Sew the sleeves along the raglan line to the front and back.

**Neck Ribbing:** Using smaller circular needle and RS facing pick up sts beg at the lower right front.

**Pick Up Row:** \*Pick up 1 st in each of 3 rows, skip next row: rep from \* for right front. K sts from holder of right sleeve, K sts from holder for back neck, K sts from holder of left sleeve. Pick up along the left front matching the number of sts along the right side. St count should be multiples of 3 + 2 for ribs to match at lower right and lower left edges.

**Neck Ribbing:** Using smaller circular needle and RS facing pick up sts beg at the lower right front.

**Pick Up Row:** \*Pick up 1 st in each of 3 rows, skip next row; rep from \* for right front. K sts from holder of right sleeve, K sts from holder for back neck, K sts from holder of left sleeve. Pick up along the left front matching the number of sts along the right side. St count should be multiples of 3 + 2 for ribs to match at lower right and lower left edges.

**Row 1 (WS):** P2, \* K1, P2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS):** K2, \* P1, K2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3 & 4:** Rep Rows 1 & 2.

**Buttonholes:** Work on left side for boys and the right side for girls. Maintain rib pattern as established.

**Boy's Row 5 (WS):** Work 3 sts, \* BO 2 sts, work 12 sts in pattern; rep from \* 4 times (5 buttonholes) and cont row in rib pattern as established.

**Girl's Row 5 (WS):** Work in rib pattern as established until 61 sts remain. \* BO 2 sts, work 12 sts in pattern; rep from \* 3 times. BO 2 sts (5 buttonholes) and work 3 rem sts in pattern.

**Row 6 (RS):** Maintain rib pattern as established. When you reach a buttonhole, CO 2 sts and cont in pattern as est.

**Row 7 & 8:** Work in rib pattern as established.

BO in pattern. Weave in yarn ends and block if necessary. Sew 5 buttons along button edge to correspond with buttonhole placement.
