Christmas Ornament Sweaters

These cute little sweaters are knit from the bottom up with raglan sleeves and decorated with embroidery.

They are sure to become part of your annual holiday decorations.

Sleeves (Make 2)

CO 10 sts, PM and join for working in the round being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-2: K1, P1 around

Rnds 3-11: Knit

Place sts on a holder.

Body (Make 1)

CO 20 sts (5 sts on needle #1, 10 sts on needle #2, 5 sts on needle #3). PM and join for working in the round being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-3: K1, P1 around

Rnds 4-13: Knit

Joining Sleeves to Body

Knit 5 sts. Using same needle, knit 5 sts from the first sleeve. Using an empty needle knit remaining 5 sts from the first sleeve. Continue with the same needle to knit 10 sts from body and 5 sts from second sleeve.

Using an empty needle, knit remaining 5 sts from second sleeve. Continue with the same needle to knit remaining 5 sts from body. You will now have 10 sts on needle 1, 20 on needle 2, and 10 on needle 3.

Raglan Decreases

Rnd 1: K3, K2tog, SSK, (K6, K2tog, SSK) three times, K3

Rnd 2: Knit

Rnd 3: K2, K2tog, SSK (K4, K2tog, SSK) three times, K2

Rnd 4: Knit

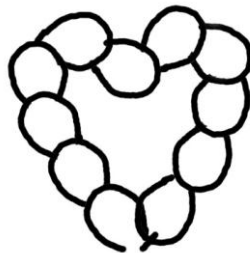
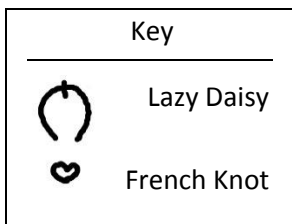
Rnd 5: K1, K2tog, SSK (K2, K2tog, SSK) three times, K1

Neck

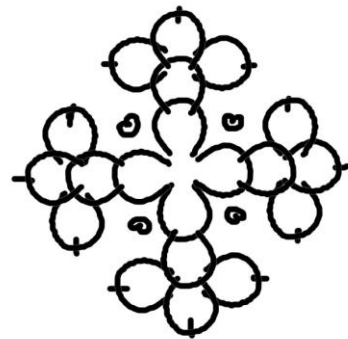
Rnds 1-9: K1, P1 around

BO in ribbing.

Work in ends, fold over turtle neck. Embroider design of your choice on sweater. Take care when embroidering with the Mauch Chunky. The yarn is a single ply and if you pull too hard it may come apart. Attach a ribbon to the back of the sweater to hang it.
