Oh Yum, Bubblegum Slouchy Hat

Knit a fun slouchy hat in Perfection Tapas. Choose your favorite color and make a hat that will not muss your hair.



Oh Yum, Bubble Gum Slouchy Hat

Cast on 84 stitches with circular needle.
PM and join being careful not to twist st(s).

Rnd 1: *K1, P1: repeat from * for rnd.
Rep Rnd 1 for 1 ¼ “.

Next rnd: K4, *K in front and back of next
stitch, K3, repeat from * to end. (104 st(s))

Body of hat:
Rows 1 and 2: K.

Row 3: *K6, yo, K2tog, repeat from * to end
of round.

Rows 4, 5, 6: K

Row 7: K2, *yo, K2tog, K6, repeat from *
across row ending last repeat with K4 in-
stead of K6.

Row 8: K

Repeat rows 1-8 until hat measures 8” from
cast on.

Dec shaping: Decrease as follows: decrease
on even rows. On odd numbered rows work
the yo, K2tog in established staggered pat-
tern as long as possible. Change to dpn
when necessary.

Row 1 and all odd rows: K or repeat pat-
tern as pattern presents self.

Row 2: * K2tog, K6, repeat across row from
*. (91 st(s))

Row 4: *K2tog, K5, repeat across row from
*. (78 st(s))

Row 6: *K2tog, K4, repeat across row from
*. (65 st(s))

Row 8: * K2tog, K3, repeat across row from
*. (52 st(s))

Row 10: *K2tog, K2, repeat across row from
*. (39 st(s))

Row 12: * K2tog, K1, repeat across row
from *. (26 st(s))

Row 14: *K2tog across row. (13 st(s))

Row 15: K2tog 6 times, K1. (7 st(s))

Remove marker.

Cut yarn leaving a 10” tail. With darning
needle draw yarn through remaining st(s).
Pull snug and weave in ends.
