Rachel's Paneled Afghan

This lovely afghan is made in four panels. Each panel is knit in a different stitch pattern, sewed together and surrounded with a seed stitch border. Our super bulky yarn makes a soft, cozy and warm fabric to cuddle up with during the winter months.



Rachel's Paneled Afghan

Four panels with different stitch patterns are knit and sewn together. The border stitches are picked up around the edge and worked in seed stitch.

Panel #1-Chevron

CO 29 st(s).

Pattern:

1. (RS) k5, *p1, k5; rep from * to end
2. k1, *p3, k3; rep from * to last 4 st(s), p3, k1
3. p2, *k1, p2; rep from * to end
4. p1, *k3, p3; rep from * to last 4 st(s), k3, p1
5. k2, *p1, k5; rep from * to last 3 st(s), p1, k2
6. purl

Repeat this pattern until the panel measures 42 inches or desired length; bind off in pattern.



Panel #2-Diamond

CO 33 st(s).

Pattern:

1. (RS) p1, *k7, p1; rep from * to end
2. k2, p5, *k3, p5; rep from * to last 2 st(s), k2
3. k1, *p2, k3, p2, k1; rep from * to end
4. p2, k2, p1, k2, *p3, k2, p1, k2; rep from * to last 2 st(s), p2
5. k3, p3, *k5, p3; rep from * to last 3 st(s), k3
6. p4, k1, *p7, k1; rep from * to last 4 st(s), p4
7. as 5th row
8. as 4th row
9. as 3rd row
10. as 2nd row

Repeat this pattern until the panel measures 42 inches or desired length; bind off in pattern.



Panel #3-Stripes

CO 22 st(s).

Pattern:

1. (RS) (and every alt. odd # row) knit
 2. *p2, k3; rep from * to last 2 st(s), p2
 4. k1, *p2, k3; rep from * to last st, p1
 6. k2, *p2, k3; rep from * to end
 8. *k3, p2; rep from * to last 2 st(s), k2
 10. p1, *k3, p2; rep from * to last st, k1
- Repeat this pattern until the panel measures 42 inches or desired length; bind off in pattern.



Panel #4-Herringbone

CO 33 st(s).

Pattern:

1. (RS) [k2,p2] twice, k1, p2, k2, p2, *k3, p2, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p2; rep from * to last 2 st(s), k2
2. p1, *k2, p2, k2, p3, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end
3. k1, *p1, k2, p2, k5, p2, k2, p1, k1; rep from * to end
4. p3, k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k2, *p5, k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 st(s), p3



Sewing the Panels Together:

Using mattress stitch, sew the panels together in whatever order you prefer.

Borders

(Note: The longer side is the horizontal side and the shorter side is the vertical side)

Horizontal

Pick up stitches in the horizontal direction:

Pick up about 109 st(s) for the first horizontal border (you may end up with more or less, but it must be an odd amount).

Using seed stitch, k1, p1 across every row for 14 rows, then bind off in pattern. The border should measure approx. 4 inches.

Repeat the directions for the second horizontal border picking up the same amount of stitches.

Vertical

Next pick up stitches in the vertical direction:

Pick up about 89 st(s) for the first vertical border (you may end up with more or less, but it must be an odd amount).

Using seed stitch, k1, p1 across every row for 14 rows, then bind off in pattern. The border should measure approx. 4 inches.

Repeat the directions for the second vertical border picking up the same amount of stitches.

Sew in all loose strands.
