US P/16 (11.5mm)

4 Buttons between 1"  
& 1.25"

# Crocheted 2.5 Hour Cowl

The 2.5 Hour Cowl is a versatile garment that allows for endless possibilities in how it is worn since there are no defined button holes. Two skeins (Four skeins for the longer version) of Perfection Yarns plus two hours of crochet time and you will end up with one super fast gift for under \$20 (\$30 for the longer version).



**Size:**

⇒ 7.5 inches by 33 inches for average height individuals

⇒ 7.5 inches by 40 inches for taller individuals (modifications listed in parentheses in pattern)

**Post Stitch DC Instructions:**

**FPdc** – Front Post Double Crochet, the crochet hook is positioned from the front then around the back of the post

**BPdc** – Back Post Double Crochet, the crochet hook is positioned from the back then around the front of the post

**Important Note:** 2 strands are held together to crochet this cowl. One strand of Perfection Worsted and one strand of Perfection

**Begin pattern:**

With N hook and holding both yarns together loosely chain 17, dc into third chain from hook (not counting chain on hook) then dc in each chain to the end of piece (15 stitches), turn, ch 2.

*Remember to keep stitches loose so texture is more visible.*

**Ribbing:**

Row 1: dc in each stitch, turn, ch 2.

Row 2: \*FPdc, BPdc\* repeat \*\* to end, turn, ch 2.

Row 3: \*BPdc, FPdc\* repeat \*\* to end.

**Switch to size P hook.** Turn, ch 2. Work one row of dc. Turn, ch 2.

**Begin pattern stitch:**

Row 1: \*FPdc, BPdc\* repeat \*\* to last stitch (this stitch is the chain two from the previous row and counts as a post stitch) BPdc in the last stitch, turn, ch 2.

Repeat *Row 1* until piece measures approximately 30.5 inches (37.5 inches) in length.

*Finished length can be altered by adding or subtracting rows.*

**Ribbing:**

Row 1: Work one row of dc.

**Switch to size N hook.** Turn, ch 2.

Row 2: \*FPdc, BPdc\* repeat \*\* to end, turn, ch 2.

Row 3: \*BPdc, FPdc\* repeat \*\* to end.

Fasten off.

**Finishing:**

Weave in ends. Locate the ribbing portion at the beginning of the cowl.

Sew on 4 buttons as follows:

Affix one button into each of the first two back post ridges then into each of the last two back post ridges.
