Penns Woods Afghan

Imagine this lovely afghan in your home draped over your bed or chair. This lacy pattern is knit in chunky weight yarn for a faster knitting experience.



Cast on 137 st(s) loosely.

Foundation row: K3, P131, K3

Row 1: (RS) K3, ssk, *K3, yo, K1, yo, K3, slip 1, K2tog, pssso, repeat from *, ending last repeat with K3, yo, K1, yo, K3 and then the last 5 stitches K2tog, K3.

All even rows (Row 2 - 16): Repeat foundation row.

Row 3: K3, ssk, *K2, yo, K3, yo, K2, slip one, K2tog, pssso, repeat from * ending last repeat with K2, yo, K3, yo, K2 and then the last 5 stitches K2tog, K3.

Row 5: K3, ssk, *K1, yo, K5, yo, K1, slip one, K2tog, pssso, repeat from * ending last repeat K1, yo, K5, yo, K1 and then the last five stitches K2tog, K3.

Row 7: K3, ssk, *yo, K7, yo, slip one, k2tog, pssso, repeat from * ending last repeat yo, K7, yo and then the last five stitches K2tog, K3.

Row 9: K4, *yo, K3, slip one, K2tog, pssso, K3, yo, K1, repeat from *, K3.

Row 11: K4, * K1, yo, K2, slip one, K2tog, pssso, K2, yo, K2, repeat from *, K3.

Row 13: K4, * K2, yo, K1, slip one, K2tog, pssso, K1, yo, K3, repeat from *, K3.

Row 15: K4, *K3, yo, slip one, K2tog, pssso, yo, K4, repeat from *, K3.

Repeat rows 1 - 16 until afghan measures approximately 66 inches or desired length.

Fringe (Optional)

Cut fringe 11 inches long (approximately two skeins required for fringe). Holding two pieces of fringe together, bring ends together. Join fringe at fold to each cast on or bound off stitch with a slip knot and a crochet hook. Lay afghan out flat and trim fringe to uniform length.
