Pip the Mouse Christmas Ornament

Celebrate the season with a happy little crocheted Christmas Mouse. He is a quick and easy ornament for your tree or a mini amigurumi for a stocking stuffer.



Head:

- Rnd 1: Ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
- Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)
- Rnd 3: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (18 sc)
- Rnds 4-7: Work even in sc.
- Rnd 8: Sc in next 5 sc (dec 1 sc) 4 times, sc in last 5 sc. (14 sc)
- Rnd 9: Work even in sc.
- Then stuff lightly before next row.
- Rnd 10: Sc in next 4 sc (dec 1 sc) 3 times, sc in last 4 sc. (11 sc)
- Rnd 11: Sc in next sc (dec 1 sc) 5 times. (6 sc)

Cut and fasten off, leaving enough yarn for closing the hole, then weave in the ends.

Next, use pink yarn to sew the nose.

Next, use black or dark brown yarn to sew small eyes above the nose.

Body:

- Rnd 1: Ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
- Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)
- Rnd 3: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (18 sc)
- Rnd 4: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (24 sc)
- Rnds 5-13: Work even in sc.
- Rnd 14: (sc in next 2 sc, dec 1 sc) 6 times. (18 sc)
- Rnd 15: (sc in next sc, dec 1 sc) 6 times. (12 sc)

Cut and fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff lightly then attach the head to the body.

Ears (make two):

- Rnd 1: Ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
- Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)
- Rnd 3: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. (18 sc)
- Rnds 4-5: Work even in sc.

Cut and fasten off, leaving a long tail. Position the ears near the back of the mouse's head and attach.

Feet (make four):

- Rnd 1: Ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
- Rnds 2-5: Work even in sc.

Cut and fasten off, leaving a long tail. Position the feet on the mouse's body and attach.

Tail:

Chain 17 and attach to the base of the mouse's body.

Scarf:

Using the color green, ch 50.
Sc in each ch for row 1, sc in each sc for a row 2.

Cut and fasten off, add fringe to ends.

Ornament hanging loop:

Ch 35, attach to mouse's head just behind the ears.
