


# Baby's Made in the USA Bib

### Kraemer Yarns Tatamy DK (45% Cotton & 55% Acrylic)

YARN



1 ball of Cherry (Main Color)1 ball of Electric Blue1 ball of Baby Powder

Measures 8" x 8"

#### GAUGE

Gauge: 5.5 sts = 1"

Needles: U.S. size 5 / 3 ¾ mm straights or 16" circular

> Notions: Large Eye Darning Needle



Our yarn is not the only thing made in the U.S.A. Cover your cutie in red, white, and blue in our easy care Tatamy yarn. Soft & completely washable. This bib has a seed stitch border, I-cord ties and duplicate stitch lettering.

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**Seed Stitch:** Knit 1, purl 1 across. Repeat on wrong side, so that purl stitches are knit, and knit stitches are purled.

M1: pick up a stitch before the next active stitch to make one new stitch. Insert the left needle from front to back into the horizontal strand between the two stitches. Knit the stitch through the back loop.

Cast on 38 stitches using the long tail method.

Rows 1-4: K1, p1 across (seed stitch bottom border)

Row 5: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, knit across to last five stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Row 6: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl across to last five stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Row 7: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, m1, knit across to last six stitches, end m1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1 (40 stitches).

Row 8: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl across to last four stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Rows 9-12: Repeat rows 7 and 8 two times (42, then 44 stitches).

Row 13: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, knit across to last five stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1 (44).

Row 14: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl across to last five stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1 (44).

Rows 15-46: Repeat rows 13-14. Your last row made will be a purl side, or wrong side row.

Row 47: K1, p1, k1, p1, k2 (k2tog x2), knit across to last ten stitches, (ssk twice), k2, p1, k1, p1, k1 (40 sts).

Row 48: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, purl across to last five stitches, end k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Row 49: K1, p1, k1, p1, k2, k2tog, knit across to last eight stitches, ssk, k2, p1, k1, p1, k1 (38 sts).

Rows 50-51: repeat rows 48-49 (36 sts).

Rows 52-55: K1, p1 across (seed stitch top border).

Row 56: K1, p1, k1, p1, k1, join a 2nd strand of the yarn, and use it to bind off center 26 stitches, end with k1, p1, k1, p1, k1.

Work each side even in seed stitch for two inches.

On each side, K2tog, p1, ssk.

Work the three stitches in I-cord for an additional tie length of 9 inches.

Cut each working yarn and thread through the stitches, pull tight and work back up through the I-cord to secure.

#### **Duplicate Stitching (Refer to chart on last page):**


Use a single strand of the Electric Blue yarn to duplicate stitch the charted color work.

In the lower right hand corner, 6 stitches to the left of the seed border and 7 stitches above the lower seed border, begin with the bottom right corner of the A of USA.

Use a single strand of the white (Baby Powder) yarn to duplicate stitch the x's at the top of the chart.

Weave in all ends on the wrong side of the bib.
