Meandering Rows Afghan

This lovely afghan is crocheted using the “crosshatch” stitch. An enjoyable stitch which creates a reversible, dense and warm fabric. The a perfect choice for your Perfection yarn.

Begin Foundation Row:

With MC chain 190 sts.

Row 1:

(Continue with MC) Skip 3 ch (this will count as 1 dc), then 2 dc in next ch, *skip 3 ch, 1 sc in next ch, ch 3, 1 dc in next 3 ch, rep from * to last 4 ch, skip 3 ch, 1 sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2:

(Continue with MC) Ch 3 (this will count as 1 dc), then 2 dc in first sc, *skip 3 dc, 1 sc in first of ch-3, ch 3, 1 dc in next 2 ch, 1 dc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 dc, skip 2 dc, 1 sc in turn ch, turn.

Note: *Rows 1 & 2 count as the first 2 rows in the first color repeat.

Remaining rows:

Repeat step 2 for each row, while following the first and second color repeats or your desired color choices.

Color sequences

Foundation row: MC

First color repeat

Next four rows: MC*
Next two rows: CC1
Next four rows: CC2
Next two rows: CC1

Second color repeat

Next four rows: MC
Next two rows: CC1
Next four rows: CC3
Next two rows: CC1

Repeat the first and second color repeats throughout.

To end, work First color repeat; then an additional 4 rows of MC.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Tip:

To make a larger afghan, add more chains to the foundation row in multiples of seven. More yarn will be required for a larger afghan.
