

Spring Treasure

Drawstring Bag

Easy to make. Convenient to use. Holds everything you need in style. Tatamy Tweed is so nice to work with, why not make one in every color?

Spring Treasure Drawstring Bag

Cast on 100 sts.

Place red marker, cast on one more stitch, then join by slipping last st to LH needle and K2tog.

Knit in Stockinette for 3/4 inches.

Round 1: *K4, P4, repeat from*

Round 2: *P4, K4, repeat from*

Round 3: repeat round 1

Round 4: repeat round 2

Knit one row.

Eyelet Round: *yo, K2tog, repeat from *

Knit five rounds.

Begin Fleck Stitch pattern.

Round 1: Knit

Round 2: Knit

Round 3: *P1, K1, repeat from*

Round 4: Knit

Repeat this pattern four times, then K50, place red marker, and K50.

Now it's your turn to be creative with the random purl stitch: While knitting from one marker to the other, randomly place one to two purl sts. Be sure to keep at least four sts between the purl sts. Continue in this manner to end of bag.

Knit three inches. Set up round: *K10, place blue marker, K30, place blue marker, K10, repeat from *

Continue with the random purls, one per marked section, and at the same time begin decrease for bottom.

Decrease:

*K10, slip marker, slip two stitches as if to knit one at a time, insert LH needle into front of sts from left to right and knit these two sts together (ssk). Knit to two sts before next marker, K2tog, K10, then repeat from *. Continue until there are ten sts between each marker.

Bind off round:

K10, BO 40 sts.

Begin flat garter stitch knitting, knit 10 ridges (20 rows).

Loosely bind off these 20 sts.

Turn the bag inside out. Match corners of flap to decreasing lines on other side and sew up.

Make one or two twisted cords to desired length, thread through every other eyelet and tie ends together. Throw in your cell phone and wallet and enjoy.
