
2 skeins

GAUGE

Gauge not critical

Needle size #7

Finished Size Approximately 50" across 26" long




This triangular shawl is great for killing the chill. Requires only 2 skeins of Belfast or Tatamy DK and perfect for your wool-free ward-robe.



CO 3 sts

Work graph, keeping in mind that odd # rows are right side rows, worked from right to left and even # rows are wrong side and are worked from left to right Repeat Rows 16-23 18 times, then work Rows 24-28 once Red outlined squares are the center repeats.

Bind Off and block shawl
